



Hoplite Power Installs Innovative Hoplite Hub Vending Machines at Citi Field

Vending Machines to Dispense Portable Chargers for Citi Field Patrons, Mets Fans to Keep Phones Charged All Season Long

NEW YORK (May 16, 2019)—[Hoplite Power](#), the company that's disrupting on-demand phone charging, announced today that it will be installing five Hoplite Hubs in Citi Field by early June. Hoplite Hubs are vending machines for Hoplites, portable phone chargers that can be rented while at stadiums, bars, restaurants, theme parks, hotels and other venues.

Rentals begin at \$4.99 per day and Hoplite Hubs accept all major credit cards, Apple Pay and Google Pay. Hoplites provide 1.5 times the charge capacity and will fully charge a phone in about 90 minutes. Fans watching Mets games or attending other Citi Field events will simply be able to swipe their credit card, get a Hoplite charger and return to their seat to continue enjoying the action.

Without Hoplite Power's chargers, fans must either be conscious to save battery power or utilize charging lockers and stations, if available. The latter requires patrons to go back and forth between their seat and phone to check the status of the charge. Hoplite's portability changes all that, allowing fans to charge their phones while watching the game from their seats.

"Our smartphones have become essential to the game-watching experience—taking photos and sharing on Instagram, posting videos to Facebook, checking fantasy baseball scores or even searching for scouting reports on a newly called up prospect," Nikolas Schreiber of Hoplite Power said. "The problem is it all takes power! All too often fans find themselves running out of battery at baseball games. There was never a solid solution to this either, as all other options came at the detriment of watching the actual game. Hoplite Power is changing that. Our technology will soon make charging lockers, stations, and tables obsolete. No more scrambling to find an outlet either."

The Mets will be customizing the branding of both Hoplite Hubs and Hoplite chargers. This customization capability creates valuable sponsorship opportunities for teams and venues. Two Hoplite Hubs will be located in Citi Field's Delta 360 Club and Porsche Suite Level. Usage of Hoplite chargers will be free to guests in these areas. The remaining three Hoplite Hubs will be stationed in the following locations:

- **Near Section 101 and the Shea Bridge behind center field; close to the Bullpen Plaza on the Field Level concourse**
- **Near Section 114 by the Jackie Robinson Rotunda and the Mets Team Store on the Field Level concourse**
- **Near Section 306 by the Coca-Cola Corner on the Excelsior Level**

"We are helping to provide Mets fans and every person who visits Citi Field with the ultimate in-ballpark experience," said Jordan Mayerson of Hoplite Power. "Fans don't go to Citi Field to charge their phones as the action unfolds on the field. With our Hoplite Hubs, Mets fans never have to miss a minute of the event they attend. They also no longer have to worry about their phone dying as they wait for an Uber or navigating home afterwards."

Hoplite chargers do not need to be returned at the same Hoplite Hub location at which they were rented. Those who use Hoplite chargers may return them at any of the Hoplite Hub locations around Citi Field.
